 - A. Consider an award of contract for leisure pool painting project at the RecPlex.

Mike Pollocoff:

Mr. President, I'm asking you to consider awards tonight for blasting and repainting the leisure pool at RecPlex. That's the warm water pool, and it's 11 years old. We had some chloramine damage on the paint and steel structure in there. We think we really got a lot of that under control probably about two or three years ago with the installation of a UV system. But nonetheless the damage is done and it's a warm environment. So what we need to do, and it's going to take four weeks to get it done, is to blast the paint down on the trusses in the ceiling and the vents and then apply a new paint product on there. I believe we've got a 20 year product or 25 year product. So we're paying a little bit of a premium but we won't have to go in and blast again.

We opened sealed bids on July 15th. We received two bids. The low bid was submitted by Walltech, Inc. for \$169,000 who is a pre-qualified bidder, as well as Porta Painting in the amount of \$514,241. So, consequently, I'm recommending we award a contract not for exterior signage but for painting to be awarded to Wall-tech.

John Steinbrink:

And they've got the same specs, right?

Same specs. I think Porta Painting does a lot of highway work, and I think they've got the painting contract on the bridges.

Michael Serpe:

Where is Wall-tech from, Mike? Not locally.

Mike Pollocoff:

No. I want to say Fond du Lac I think.

Michael Serpe:

That's almost local. We don't have much of a choice here. I would move approval of the award to Wall-tech, Inc. for \$169,000.

Steve Kumorkiewicz:

Second.

John Steinbrink:

Motion by Mike, second by Steve. Further comment or question?
