

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS STH 50 SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Village Board of the Village of Pleasant Prairie, Kenosha County, Wisconsin has adopted a preliminary resolution (#20-13) declaring its intention to exercise its police power to levy special assessments pursuant to section 66.0703, Wis. Stats., upon property within the proposed assessment district which is includes one vacant parcel (tax key 91-4-122-054-0270), in the Village of Pleasant Prairie. The project generally consists of: 1) 8-inch sanitary sewer relay and extension along STH 50 beginning at 91st Avenue and extending west approximately 250-feet.

You are further notified that the Governing body will hear all interested persons, or their agents or attorneys, concerning matters contained in the preliminary resolution authorizing the assessments and the above described report at 6:00 p.m. on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of August, 2020. The public hearing will be conducted virtually on the internet utilizing a web-based application called GoToWebinar. The hearing will be held during the Village Board meeting which starts at 5:00 p.m, however, the hearing will not start until 6:00p.m. This will be the last meeting held concerning the project special assessment. All objections will be considered at this hearing and thereafter the amount of the assessments will be finally determined.

There will be an opportunity for the public comment during the session. To access the virtual meeting, register in advance online at <a href="PleasantPrairieWi.gov/MainExtension">PleasantPrairieWi.gov/MainExtension</a>. Once registered, you will receive log in instructions via email. The night of the meeting registered users will need to follow emailed login instructions to access the virtual meeting. Users that utilize this method will have an opportunity to raise a virtual hand to speak during the public comment portion of the meeting. All comments received before noon on August 3rd, 2020 will be distributed to the board and considered at the meeting. The last option is to attend in person a virtual site at the Village Hall Auditorium. Please note Village Board and Committee members will not be present at Village Hall, and will participate in the meeting virtually. In-person

attendance is not recommended due to concerns surrounding COVID-19 but those wishing to attend this virtual site at Village Hall, please RSVP by calling (262) 925.6729.
